TIDES SERIES

Tides is a series that emerges from the experience of landscape understood as a living system, in constant transformation. The work is built through long-term observation of territory and sea, particularly tidal movements, which act as a dynamic structure capable of continuously rewriting space and perception.

The series does not seek to describe a specific geography or represent a particular place. Instead, it proposes a contemporary reading of territory. Landscape is presented as an open experience in which architecture, artwork, and viewer relate through movement, pauses, and sensory variations. Within this silent dialogue, a shared responsibility is activated almost unconsciously: to observe, value, and care for water as a vital resource.

Tides is conceived as a spatial experience rather than a collection of works displayed on walls. Through large-scale murals, monumental textile installations, and site-specific interventions, the work activates the exhibition space and engages in dialogue with architecture, natural or artificial light, the scale of the room, and the visitor's time of presence. Each installation adapts uniquely to its institutional context, responding to spatial dimensions, lighting conditions, and architectural characteristics.

Although the work draws from personal experiences linked to the Mediterranean, the Caribbean, and other sea-related territories, it transcends individual experience to become a space for collective reflection. Encounters with marine ecosystems, local cultures, and the people who inhabit these landscapes continuously enrich the meaning of the series and reinforce its mutable nature.

From this perspective, Tides proposes a reflection on the fragility of aquatic ecosystems and the urgency of their protection, integrating art, perception, and environmental awareness. The project expands into an educational and community-oriented dimension through workshops and participatory activities that connect art, culture, and sustainability, opening the museum space to new generations and affirming it as a living place in constant dialogue with its environment.





Inspired by my recent visits to Singapore.

An organic deconstruction leads to the purest and most simplified forms of nature. This contemporary expression of lush vegetation, though unlike the dense forests of Patagonia, manages to captivate you for a moment, as if you were in the very heart of the Misiones jungle.

The colorful backgrounds in greenish, pinkish, or bluish tones, with branching elements at the top reminiscent of Eastern symbols, pay homage to the Southeast Asian culture and the environmental commitment of this marvelous city-state—a model of biodiversity where only spontaneity is allowed in the greenery of its parks and the confines of the canvases.

The various hues represented in the vibrant backgrounds of the works, as if reflecting an illuminated night at Gardens by the Bay with its nocturnal light show, play with colors such as vibrant pinks, grayish purples, and other tones to simulate a light spectacle against the white canvas background.

This series will leave no one indifferent, especially to those who have had the opportunity to visit the artificial tree structures housing over 100 different types of plants or any of Singapore's corners

_ REVIEW

PEACE AT ITS HIGHEST TENSION

Ingrid Haubrich's works make a great visual impact. The way she fills the space, brings together and swirls color, lets us see all that she has to say from the dramatic tension she creates in the image. The stormy chiaroscuro and the open forms that appear like tongues, seem to drag the viewer into a turbulent interior. How can our artist possess such a graceful, proportionate and harmonious figure and at the same time contain such impulsive rushes? Ingrid does not deceive, if she deceives herself. All this disappears as she paints.

This new series, entitled "Tides" ("Mareas"), alludes to the Alternating and periodical movement of ascent and descent that, like the sea, also occurs in the consciousness of people. In his painting, there is agitation both what tries to come out, as well as what remains in the background.

"I would like the viewer of my works to find the same tranquility and harmony that I find the same tranquility and harmony that painting them gives me". For Ingrid, impetuosity is in life, not in art. Thus, she seeks that each painting to be the imprint of an energy to live."

Painting gives me peace," she says. For this reason it is a finding that the work is exhibited in a center of spirituality. The blues associated with the celestial testify to this.

Sabemos que convertiste tu hobby por la pintura en una carrera que cada año se vuelve más sólida. ¿Cómo se da este proceso? Siempre estuve relacionada al mundo del diseño. Mi padre es arquitecto y mi madre es interiorista, ambos en Argentina. Me mudé a España y decidí estudiar Interiorismo en la Escuela de Bellas Artes. Hoy tengo estudios en ambos países. Tengo la suerte de contar con un gran equipo que me permite que pueda dedicarme a lo que realmente me apasiona, que es el arte. Comencé a pintar hace unos años buscando esa paz que me alejara un poco de la vorágine laboral. En un principio firmaba mis obras con un seudónimo (con el fin de escuchar la verdadera crítica). Luego comencé a trabajar de una forma más profesional y logré mi primera exposición en solitario en Buenos Aires. A partir de ahí, nada paró.

Cuéntanos un poco de esos primeros pasos. En esa primera exposición en solitario, un gran crítico de arte argentino, Julio Sapolnik, se acercó a ver mi serie Mareas. Tras compartirme una magnífica crítica, me invitó a exponer en el Museo Borges. Obviamente, y sin pensarlo dos veces, creé cinco obras enormes que fueron el foco de la sala. Ahí mismo recibí la invitación a participar en ferias en Nueva York y Miami.

Tus espectaculares Mareas han llegado a República Dominicana causando furor. ¿Cómo surge esta serie y cuál es el mensaje detrás? Estoy feliz con la aceptación que ha tenido mi obra en República Dominicana. Estoy enamorada del país, de la alegría de su gente y del sentimiento que tienen hacia el arte. La serie Mareas, que ha entrado con muy buen pie en la isla, está compuesta por obras de gran formato, en las que resaltan distintas tonalidades de azules vibrantes y movimientos que simulan tempestades. La serie busca crear conciencia sobre la importancia de proteger el medio ambiente y cuidar nuestras aguas, mares y océanos. También es una manera de que el coleccionista introduzca en sus viviendas un poco de la tranquilidad y la paz que la obra nos regala cuando nos sentamos a admirarla.

Háblanos de la técnica y materiales que usas. Pinto sobre el suelo y descalza, debido al gran formato de las obras, y raras veces uso pinceles. Son acrílicos sobre lienzos, que se suman a un estado de calma. Es una conexión profunda que se da entre mis espátulas y el lienzo. Me transporta desde mi estudio a la calma de la orilla del mar. Ese estado de paz es la técnica que mejor me funciona.
